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Summary:

New treatments including targeted and immune modulating therapy have revolutionized oncology over the last decade. In clinical studies, these new treatments have shown remarkable higher efficacy and potentially also long term responses. However, the crucial question whether these new achievements also result in longer survival of oncology patients in general, remains unanswered. We aim to analyse the data of approximately 30 000 individual patients treated at the Division of Oncology, Department of Medicine 1 between 2004 and 2019 to retrieve insight on changes in clinical characteristics over time.
